

Vermont Systems and E-Seek Join Forces to Automate Army Recreational Facilities

Vermont Systems flagship product RecTrac is currently installed at all Army MWR activities worldwide. E-Seek, Inc. recently supplied their patented 2D barcode readers to work with RecTrac at these facilities. The reader allows military personnel to use their DoD ID cards to swipe into facilities without the need for custom recreation ID cards. Facilities will experience an increase in efficiency and accuracy while registering and validating military personnel and their dependents usage of the recreational facilities. Several hundred facilities are now able to track the usage of their recreational facilities by electronically reading and validating the ID in a fraction of time.

The Army installations represent the first time that E-Seek and Vermont Systems have partnered to provide electronic ID reading. As the usage of 2D barcodes is now common on many government issued IDs and drivers licenses, Vermont Systems expects to expand the use of the E-Seek readers into their municipal parks and recreation market. The two companies will also continue to expand their military presence with the Navy, Marines and Air Force who have the same swiping needs as the Army. Together E-Seek and Vermont Systems have formed a partnership to provide access control and usage demographics to the recreation community.
